

"GIVIN' IT UP" SELECTED FOR SCREENINGS IN TORONTO AND SAN DIEGO!

The award-winning documentary 'Givin It Up', directed by independent film maker W.R.Stanton of Main Point Productions, has been selected for screening at the 117th Annual Convention of the American Psychological Association in Toronto on August 8, and at the 14th International Conference on Violence, Abuse, and Trauma in San Diego on September 23.

Executive-produced by sexuality experts Drs. Susan Kraus and Robert Gill, founders and Co-Directors of Reading Specialists Offender Treatment Services, 'Givin it Up' chronicles the experiences and perspectives of convicted adolescent sex offenders as they struggle with rehabilitation. With commentary by international treatment experts, law enforcement professionals and a Common Pleas Judge, 'Givin It Up' puts a human face on young sexual abuse victims and offenders alike. These are the most recent of several honors garnered by the film, including Finalist for Best Documentary at the New York Independent Film & Video Festival and a Director's Citation at the Black Maria Film Festival.

Main Point Productions is a digital media production company specializing in social issues documentaries. A sequel to 'Givin' It Up', working titled 'Scarlet Letter', is currently in pre-production 'Scarlet Letter' will focus on the impact of state "Megan's Laws" and the federal Adam Walsh Act on law enforcement, public safety and civil liberties.
